

**Ordinance No. 10.**

**RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE AND QUIET.**

**Assault and Battery, Riot, Rout or Affray.**

Section I. Be it Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, That no person or persons shall, within the corporate limits of said village of South Jacksonville, commit any assault, or assault and battery upon any person or persons, or shall be engaged in any riot, rout, or affray, and every person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay the said village of South Jacksonville not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every offense.

**Permitting Disturbance of the Peace**

Sec. 2. No person shall, in any house or place used or occupied by him or her, within the limits of said village of South Jacksonville suffer or permit hallooing, shouting, bawling, screaming, the use of profane or abusive language, fighting, dancing, singing, whooping, quarreling, or any other unusual noises or sounds to be made in such a manner as to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood or those passing through the streets; and every person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said village of South Jacksonville not less than three nor more than twenty dollars for the first offense, and for every subsequent offense not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars.

**Disturbing the Peace**

Sec. 3. No person shall halloo, shout, bawl, scream, use profane or obscene language, dance, sing, whoop, quarrel or make any unusual noise or sound in any house, or in any part of said village in such a manner as to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood or those passing through the streets, or conduct himself in an incident or disorderly manner in any hotel, railroad, saloon, auction room, or other public office or place in said village; and every person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said village of South Jacksonville not less than three nor more than twenty dollars for the first offense, and for every subsequent offense not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars.

**Disturbing Any Assemblage or Meeting.**

Sec. 4. No person shall within, the corporate limits of said village, disturb any lawful assemblage of people by whistling, shouting, screaming, or make any other loud or unnecessary noise, or by rude or indecent behavior, either within the place of assemblage or so near the same the same as to disturb the peace or order of the meeting; and every person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said village of South Jacksonville, not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars.

**Using Abusive or Insulting Language**

Sec. 5. No person shall, within the corporate limits of said village, use any language personally abusive and insulting, such as tends to produce a disturbance and breach of peace; and any person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to said village not less than three nor more than twenty dollars for each and every offense.
