ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 57

Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1933 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1933.

Section 1. Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, in the County of Morgan and State of Illinois; that there be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1933 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1933, for the use of the said Village of South Jacksonville, the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) for the purposes and in the amounts as hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys	\$ 2300.
For street lighting	400.
For salaries	400.
For fire department	800.
For election expenses	100.
For sewers	800.
For water mains	9000.
For Court coats	100.
For sundry expenses	100.

Making a total of	\$ 14000.
