ORDINANCE NO. 64

Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1924 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1925.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1924 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1925, for the use of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, the sum Thirty-five Thousand Dollars, for the purposes and in the amounts as hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys	\$3000.00
For street lighting	500.00
For salaries	500.00
For the Fire Department	1000.00
For election expenses	100.00
For sewers	5000.00
For water mains	2000.00
For attorney fees	1000.00
For court costs	500.00
For sundry expenses	400.00
For public benefits assessed against the Village for paving South Main Street, and the intersections thereof	20000.00
For engineer's fees	1000.00
