

AN ORDINANCE PREPARED AND TRANSMITTED, AND ITS PASSAGE RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, TO THE VILLAGE BOARD OF SAID VILLAGE, PROVIDING FOR THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT TO BE KNOWN AS THE SOUTH MAIN STREET PAVING DISTRICT, SAID PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT TO BE THE EXCAVATING, GRADING, CURBING AND PAVING OF SOUTH MAIN STREET FROM THE CENTER LINE OF MICHIGAN AVENUE TO THE SOUTH PROPERTY LINE OF WEST VANDALIA ROAD, AND THE ROADWAYS OF ALL INTERSECTING AND TERMINATING STREETS INCLUDED IN SAID PAVING DISTRICT, AND FOR THE DRAINAGE OF STORM WATER IN SAID DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That there be constructed in the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois a local improvement to be made by special taxation, which shall be known and designated as the South Main Street Paving District of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, the nature, character, locality and description of which said local improvement are hereinafter set forth; said improvement to be constructed in accordance with the specifications herein set forth, and according to the plans prepared by the Caldwell Engineering Company of Jacksonville, Illinois, a copy of which plans are on file with the Village Clerk; all elevations therein shown are referred to a Bench Mark which is a large spike driven into the base of a soft maple tree, three feet in diameter, located twenty-five feet East of the center line of South Main Street and One Hundred and Thirty-five (135) feet south of the center line of Michigan Avenue, the elevation of said Bench Mark being 625.1'; all elevations, when referring to the pavement, indicate the top of the crown of the pavement.
