

## ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS

PROVIDING FOR THE LAYING OF CERTAIN WATER  
MAINS, SETTING OF CERTAIN FIRE HYDRANTS  
AND ACCEPTING THE BID THEREFOR

Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the  
Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois,

Section 1. That four inch cast iron water mains be laid on Pennsylvania Avenue from South Main Street to South West Street; from South Main Street on East Greenwood Avenue to South Clay Avenue; on South East Street from East Greenwood Avenue to East Vandalla Road; and on East Vandalla Road from South East Street to South Clay Avenue;

Section 2. That a four inch Mathews fire hydrant be installed at the corner of South West Street and Pennsylvania Avenue; one at South East Street and East Greenwood Avenue; one at South Clay Avenue and East Vandalla Road, and one at East Vandalla Road and South East Street;

Section 3. That said water mains and fire hydrants, together with all necessary fittings and installing of the same be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the Village Clerk, and that the cost thereof be paid by general taxation.

Section 4. That the bid of Sheehan & McNamara in the amount of Forty-one Hundred and Forty and no/100 <sup>for fur-</sup>  
upon a basis of thirty-seven hundred feet of pipe, nishing all necessary material and equipment, and doing all the necessary and proper work, including excavating and backfilling, for the proper installation of said water mains and fire hydrants, all in accordance with said plans and specifications, be and the same is hereby accepted, conditioned upon the said Sheehan & McNamara entering into proper bond for the protection of said Village during the progress of said work.
