TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 81

Tax Levy Ordinance for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1926, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1927

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is levied upon all property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, aforesaid, as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes, for the current year, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, for the purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth, said amounts having heretofore been appropriated in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of said Village:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys	\$1500.00
For street lighting	800.00
For salaries	200.00
For fire department	600.00
For sewers	1000.00
For water mains	600.00
For attorney fees	100.00
For election expenses	100.00
For sundry expenses	100.00
Making a total of	\$5000.00

Section 2. That all unexpended balances of any item or items may be used or expended to make up deficits in any item or items herein specified.

Passed and approved by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, at a regular meeting held on the First Day of September, A. D. 1926.
