ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE No. 84

Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1927 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1928.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, Illinois

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1927 and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1928, for the use of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars, for the purposes and in the amounts as hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys	\$3000.00
For street lighting	1000.00
For salaries	500.00
For the Fire Department	600.00
For election expenses	100.00
For sewers	4000.00
For water mains	3000.00
For Boulevard Lighting System	5000.00
For attorney fees	300.00
For court costs	200.00
For public benefits assessed against Village	1800.00
For sundry expenses	500.00
