ORDINANCE NO. 89

Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1939 and ending with the Monday next preceeding the third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1940:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1939 and ending with the Monday next preceeding the third Tuesday in April, A. D. 1940, for the use of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, the sum of One Hundred and fifteen Thousand Dollars, for the purposes and in the amounts as hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys	\$4,000.00
For street lighting	1,000.00
For salaries	500.00
For the Fire Department	800.00
For election expenses	100.00
For sewers, including outlet sewers	75,000.00
For treatment plant and rights therein	25,000.00
For water mains	5,000.00
For boulevard lighting system	5,000.00
For attorney fees	500.00
For court costs	500.00
For public benefits assessed against the Village for sundry expenses	1,800.00
