

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDINANCE PASSED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, ON NOVEMBER 21st, 1929, WHICH ORDINANCE WAS ENTITLED AS FOLLOWS:
"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT TO BE KNOWN AS THE 'OPENING OF SOUTH CLAY AND EAST PENNSYLVANIA AVENUES'".

SECTION 1: Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, that an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Local Improvement to be Known as the 'Opening of South Clay and East Pennsylvania Avenues'", passed and approved by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, on November 21st, 1929, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
