

ORDINANCE NO. 626

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 333 AND
REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
PORTIONS OF WEST MICHIGAN AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE
OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That an Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Regulating the
Speed of Motor Vehicles on the Streets and Alleys in the Village of South
Jacksonville", as amended, also known as Ordinance No. 333 adopted on the 17th
day of October, 1965, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting after
Section 1 thereof the following Section:

"Section 1(A). That portion of West Michigan Avenue
lying west of the west right-of-way line of
Tendick
Street and extending to
the east right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue is hereby
established as a School Zone and it shall be unlawful
for any person to drive a motor vehicle in such Zone
at a speed greater than 20 m.p.h. on school days
when children are present."
