

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS FOR CERTAIN CORPORATE PURPOSES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1944, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1945.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, that there be and there hereby is appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, 1944, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, 1945, the sum of Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$14,400.00) for the purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling, graveling, and repairing streets and alleys	\$ 5000.00
For street lighting	600.00
For salaries	1000.00
For rental of fire equipment	750.00
For election expenses	100.00
For extensions and repairs of water mains	1000.00
For sewage disposal and treatment	1000.00
For maintenance and operation of sewage pumping station	1000.00
For extensions and repairs of sewage collection system	1000.00
For legal expenses	750.00
For incidental expenses	500.00
For payment of principal and interest on general obligation bonds	1700.00
Total	\$14400.00
