

ORDINANCE # 171.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS FOR CERTAIN CORPORATE PURPOSES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL 1947, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, that there be, and there hereby is, appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April 1947, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April 1948, the sum of Thirty-nine Thousand One Hundred and Fifty Dollars, (\$39,150.00) for the purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth;

For construction of Village Garage	\$3000.00
For opening, widening, improving, oiling, graveling and repairing streets and alleys	\$6,000.00
For street lighting	700.00
For salaries	800.00
For rental of fire equipment	500.00
For election expenses	100.00
For extensions and repair of water mains	8,000.00
For sewage disposal and treatment	1,200.00
For maintenance and operation of sewage pumping station	1,000.00
For extensions and repairs of sewage collection system	1,000.00
For construction of Hardin Avenue gravity sewer	15,000.00
For incidental expense	300.00
For payment of principal and interest on general obligation bonds,	<u>1,550.00</u>
T o t a l - - - - -	\$39,150.00
