

ORDINANCE # 172

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1947, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that there be and there hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said Village for the fiscal year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, 1947, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, 1948, the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars, for the uses and purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling, graveling, and repairing streets and alleys - - - - -	\$ 1000.00
For street lighting - - - - -	\$ 400.00
For salaries - - - - -	\$ 800.00
For maintenance and operation of sewage pumping station - - - - -	\$ 720.00
For extensions and repairs of water mains - - - - -	\$ 500.00
For incidental expenses - - - - -	\$ 180.00
<u>LEVY TOTAL - - - - -</u>	<u>\$ 3600.00</u>

Passed and approved at a regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, held on the 6th day of August, A.D., 1947, at the Village Hall in said Village.
