

ORDINANCE # 175.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS FOR CERTAIN CORPORATE PURPOSES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1948, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1949.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, that there be, and there hereby is, appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, 1948, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, 1949, the sum of Nineteen Thousand One hundred Dollars (\$19,100.00) for the purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling, graveling and repairing streets and alleys,	\$ 5,000.00
For street lighting,	450.00
For salaries,	800.00
For rental of fire equipment,	400.00
For election expenses,	100.00
For extensions and repair of water mains,	6,500.00
For sewage disposal and treatment,	1,400.00
For maintenance and operation of sewage pumping station,	1,500.00
For extensions and repairs of sewage collection system,	1,000.00
For legal expenses,	300.00
For incidental expenses,	150.00
For payment of principal and interest on general obligation bonds,	<u>1,500.00</u>
Total	\$19,100.00
