AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN AND FOR THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ON THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1950, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF SAID VILLAGE THE PROPOSITION OF ISSUING \$12,000.00 FIRE EQUIPMENT BONDS OF SAID VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, deem it advisable and necessary, and for the best interests of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, that fire equipment be acquired for the protection of the inhabitants and the property in said Village, said equipment to consist of fire engine, pumps, hose, station, and all necessary appurtenances thereto; and

WHEREAS, this President and Board of Trustees of said Village has heretofore estimated the cost of acquiring such fire equipment, and does hereby estimate that it will cost not less than \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funds are not available for said purpose, and it will therefore be necessary to borrow money, and in evidence thereof issue general obligation bonds of said Village to pay the cost thereof, and before general obligation bonds can be issued, the question of issuing said bonds must be submitted to the voters of said Village, and approved by a majority of the electors voting on said question at an election called for that purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, the proposition of issuing bonds of said Village for the purpose of paying the cost of fire equipment to provide fire protection for said Village, to the amount of \$12,000.00, dated

October 1, 1950, bearing interest at the rate of two and one-half percent (2½%) per annum, payable on the 1st day of November, 1951, and semi-annually thereafter on the first day of May and November in each year, and to mature \$1,000.00 on November 1 of each of the years 1951 to 1962, inclusive, a special election be, and is hereby called to be held in and for said Village on the 26th day of September, 1950, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M., and 5:00 o'clock P.M.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of said election, the entire territory within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville be, and it hereby is designated as one polling precinct.

SECTION 3. That the polling place of said precinct for said special election shall be at the Village Hall, in the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois.

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to cause at least fifteen, but not more than thirty days notice of such election by publishing a notice in the Jacksonville Courier, a newspaper of general circulation in said Village, there being no newspaper published within said Village, and by posting notices at least fifteen, but not more than thirty days before said election in at least three of the most public places in said Village, and at the polling place in said Village. Both published and posted notices shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That on the 26th day of September, 1950, a special election will be held in the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

Shall bonds in the amount of \$12,000.00 be issued by the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, for the purpose of paying the cost of fire equipment to provide fire protection for said Village, said fire equipment to consist of engine, pumps, hose, station and all necessary appurtenances thereto, bonds to be dated October 1, 1950, maturing \$1,000.00 on November 1, in each of the years 1951 to 1962, inclusive, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed two and one-half percent ($2\frac{1}{2}\%$) per annum?

The following is the polling places for said special election:

Village Hall, in the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois.

The polls at said election will be open at 6:00 o'clock in the forenoon, and will be closed at 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day. All persons qualified to vote at general Municipal elections in the Village of South Jacksonville, are entitled to vote on said proposition.

SECTION 5. That the ballots to be used at said Special Election on said proposition shall be in substantially the following form:

SECTION 7. Due to the present uncertainty of the availability of fire equipment, materials and apparatus, and due to the necessity of providing continuous fire protection for the citizens and property of the Village of South Jacksonville, it is hereby determined that an emergency exists and that this ordinance may be introduced and passed at a special meeting of the President and Board of Trustees called for this purpose.

SECTION 8. That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, be, and the same hereby are repealed.

SECTION 9. That this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
