AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
THE ELECTION OF PRESIDENT,
CLERK AND THREE TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSON-
VILLE, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Statutes of the State of Illinois,
the President of the Village of South Jacksonville is to be
elected at the next general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Statutes of the State of Illinois,
the Village Clerk is to be elected at the next general election;
and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois,
three trustees are to be elected at the next general election;
and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Statutes of the State of Illinois
said election is to be held on the third Tuesday in April, 1951;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board
of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1. That an election shall be held in the Village
of South Jacksonville Morgan County, Illinois, between the hours
of 6:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., on Tuesday, April 17, 1951, for the
purpose of electing a President, a Clerk, and three members of
the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville;

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of said election the entire
territory within the corporate limits of the Village of South
Jacksonville be, and it hereby is designated as one polling
precinct;

SECTION 3. That the polling place of said precinct shall be
at the Village Hall, located in Dewey Park in said Village;

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to
cause at least fifteen, but not more than thirty days notice of
such election by publishing a notice in the Jacksonville Courier
a newspaper of general circulation in said Village, there be-
no newspaper published within said Village, said notice to
substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF ELECTION
VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE,
MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Public notice is hereby given, that on Tuesday, April 17, 1951, an election will be held in the Village of South Jacksonville for the purpose of electing a President, Village Clerk, and three Trustees of the Village Board of South Jacksonville;

The Village Hall in Dewey Park in the Village of South Jacksonville is the polling place for said election.

The polls at said election will be open at 6:00 o'clock in the forenoon and will be closed at 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day. All persons qualified to vote at general municipal elections are entitled to vote.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk be, and hereby is directed to cause the printing of the ballots and the obtaining of supplies necessary to conduct said election;

SECTION 7. That this ordinance be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
