

ORDINANCE NO. 206.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1952, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY LAST PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1953.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, in the County of Morgan, in the State of Illinois, did on the second day of July, 1952, pass the annual appropriation bill for the said Village of South Jacksonville for the fiscal year beginning on the third Tuesday in April, 1952, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April, 1953, the amount of which is ascertained to be in the aggregate sum of twenty-eight thousand, one hundred fifty dollars (\$28,150.00), which said appropriation bill was duly published on the 10th day of July, 1952.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1. That there be, and is hereby, levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said Village for the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April, 1952, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April, 1953, the total sum of five thousand, seven hundred fifty dollars (\$5,750.00) for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 2. That there be, and there hereby is, levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of South Jacksonville, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year A. D. 1952, pursuant to the authorization of Article 39, Chapter 24, Revised Statutes of Illinois, heretofore adopted at a special election duly and regularly held on November 7th, 1950, the total sum of one thousand, six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$1,666.00) for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the sum as follows:

SECTION 3. The Village Clerk of said Village of South Jacksonville is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Morgan County a duly certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

PASSED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, at a regular meeting held on the 6th day of August, 1952, at the Village Hall in said Village.
