

*ORDINANCE # 209*

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE  
ELECTION OF PRESIDENT, CLERK AND  
THREE TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF  
SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois, the President of the Village of South Jacksonville is to be elected at the next general election; also a Clerk; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois three (3) members of the Board of Trustees are to be elected at the next general election; and

WHEREAS, said election, pursuant to statute, is to be held on the third Tuesday in April, 1953.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1. That an election shall be held in the Village of South Jacksonville, County of Morgan and State of Illinois, between the hours of 6:00 A. M., and 5:00 P. M., on Tuesday, April 21st, 1953, for the purpose of electing a President, a Clerk and three (3) members of the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of said election the entire territory within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville be, and it hereby is, designated as one polling precinct.

SECTION 3. That the polling place of said precinct shall be at the Village Hall located in Dewey Park in said Village.

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk be, and hereby is, directed to cause at least fifteen but not more than thirty days notice of such election by publishing a notice in the Jacksonville Courier, a newspaper of general circulation in said Village, there being no newspaper published within said Village, said notice to be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION  
 VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE  
 MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Public notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, April 21st, 1953, an election will be held in the Village of South Jacksonville for the purpose of electing a President, a Clerk and three members of the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville.

The Village Hall in Dewey Park in the Village of South Jacksonville is the polling place for said election. The polls at said election will be open at 6:00 O'clock in the forenoon, and will be closed at 5:00 O'clock in the afternoon of said day. All persons qualified to vote at general municipal elections are entitled to vote.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
