

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF
MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS
IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED By the President and Board of Trustees of
the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1. No person shall drive a vehicle upon any public highway, street or alley within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, at a speed greater than reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and the use of the way, or so as to endanger the life or limb, or injure the property of any person. If the rate of speed of any vehicle on any public highway, street or alley where the same passes through the business district of this Village, exceeds twenty miles per hour, or if the rate of speed of any such vehicle operated on the public highway, street or alley passing through the residence district of said Village exceeds twenty-five miles per hour, such rates of speed shall be prima facie evidence that the person operating such motor vehicle is running at a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and the use of the way, or so as to endanger the life or limb, or injure the property of any person.

SECTION 2. No person shall drive or operate any vehicle with a willfull or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois.

SECTION 3. No vehicle shall be operated or allowed to remain upon any street in such manner as to form an unreasonable obstruction of the traffic thereon.


SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to make any turn or movement of said motor vehicle unless he has first complied with the traffic laws of the State of Illinois in regard to giving the proper signal for the turn or movement of the vehicle contemplated.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00), nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.
