AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE, LICENSE OR PERMIT TO ELM CITY BUS LINES, INCORPORATED, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A MOTOR BUS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION FOR HIRE OF PASSENGERS AS A COMMON CARRIER, AND FIXING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH GRANT."

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of an ordinance entitled

"AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE, LICENSE OR PERMIT TO ELM CITY BUS LINES, INCORPORATED, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A MOTOR BUS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION FOR HIRE OF PASSENGERS AS A COMMON CARRIER, AND FIXING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH GRANT."

passed and approved on the 4th day of March, 1942, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 7. Fares.

Fares covering one continuous ride on the regularly established routes within the city limits of the City of Jacksonville, Illinois, the village limits of South Jacksonville, Illinois and adjacent unincorporated territory shall be as follows:

Cash fare five cents (5¢)

Children under six (6) years of age when accompanied by an adult will be hauled free of charge; otherwise the regular fare will be paid. A continuous ride begins when the passenger enters a bus and ends when the same bus arrives at 40 N. Side Public Square, Jacksonville, Illinois."

SECTION 2. Effective date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and passage, according to law.
