

ORDINANCE NO. 499,

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE

WHEREAS, a written Petition, under oath, signed by the owners of record of the land described in said Petition and hereinafter described, has been filed with the Village Clerk of the Village requesting annexation to the Village of South Jacksonville of the territory described in said Petition, and

WHEREAS, all the electors residing on the said described territory have joined in the Petition for annexation, and

WHEREAS, said territory is contiguous to the Village of South Jacksonville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described territory be and it is hereby annexed to the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois:

Part of Lot Eleven (11) in Gallaher's Second Addition to Jacksonville, now vacated, described as follows:

Beginning
at a point 153 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Lot 11, running thence East 100 feet, thence North 90 feet, thence West 100 feet and thence South 90 feet to the point of beginning, and all of the right of way of Greenwood Avenue South of and adjacent to the above described premises.

Section 2. A copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the annexed territory shall be recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Morgan County, Illinois.

PETITION TO ANNEX TERRITORY TO VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE

TO: THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE:

The undersigned, being the owner of record and fifty-one percent (51%) of the electors residing in the land hereinafter described, hereby petition the Village of South Jacksonville to annex to the Village of South Jacksonville the following described tract of real estate:

A part of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 29, Township 15 North, Range 10 West of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning
at a point 40 feet North and 1110 feet East of the Southwest corner of said quarter quarter section, thence North 232 feet 3 inches, thence West 420 feet, thence South 232 feet 3 inches, thence East 420 feet to the place of beginning (being vacated Lots 29, 30 and the West 120 feet of Lots 31 and 32 in Gallaher's Second Addition to Jacksonville, now vacated), except the following: Beginning at a point 690 feet East and 40 feet North of a stone on the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 15 North, Range 10 West of the Third Principal Meridian, and extending thence North 110 feet, thence East 50 feet, thence South 110 feet, thence West 50 feet to the point of beginning; also, all of the right of way of Greenwood Avenue South of and adjacent to the above described premises.
