We, the undersigned, members of the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, acting as and exercising the powers vested by law in a Highway Commissioner of Road District No. 15 of Morgan County, Illinois, do hereby certify that a meeting was held in the Village Hall of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, in said Road District No. 15, on the day of September, A. D. 1977, for the purpose of determining the amounts of money necessary for roads, bridges, culverts, storm sewers, machinery, and repairs and to be certified to the County Board.

We do further certify that at said annual meeting held in the Village Hall of said Village of South Jacksonville, on the day of September, A. 



RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

That the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois desires to hereby register with the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois said Village's objections to parts of the proposed plans for widening South Main Street in Jacksonville and South Jacksonville, Illinois from Morton Avenue south to the interchange of the Central Illinois Expressway, also known as Route 36 and said Village's objections are as follows:

(1) The Village is informed that the Department of Transportation is considering plans whereby there will be a four-lane road from Morton Avenue to Dewey Drive and at this point said road would be narrowed to a two-lane road extending to the south side of the intersection of said South Main Street and Vandalia Road. The Village of South Jacksonville believes that if there is any need for a four-lane pavement on said South Main Street in the first place, a useless bottleneck in traffic would occur by narrowing a portion of the road to two lanes and further believes that such a two-lane segment would render useless the four-lane segment and create a large traffic back-up and a hazard to the public safety.

(2) That the foregoing bottleneck will occur because the intersection of South Main Street and Vandalia Road is a heavily travelled intersection throughout the day and at certain periods of the day traffic is even heavier due to employees going to and from work at the Hertzberg New Method Book Bindery which employs approximately five hundred (500) persons and which has several large trucks traveling to and from the establishment. Further, that the excessive flow of traffic to Nichols Park on holidays and weekends would create an additional bottleneck of traffic at the intersection.

(3) It would appear that said intersection is going to be more heavily travelled due to the increased traffic to and from the Central Illinois Expressway, Route 36 interchange, and due to new housing

developments on East Vandalia Road and possible new housing developments on South Main south of Vandalia. In addition, the Mobil Chemical Company has purchased property north of East Vandalia Road on which they plan to build in the near future, and to which large tractor-trailer units would travel. The present intersection is extremely narrow for such trucks making right turns.

(4) The Village of South Jacksonville is informed that the Department of Transportation is considering plans whereby there will be a two-lane concrete roadway with blacktop lanes on each side of said concrete extending south from Vandalia Road to the Central Illinois Expressway interchange. The Village of South Jacksonville believes that such construction is not adequate for the present flow of traffic on said road and the increased flow anticipated in the near future and said Village believes that this type of construction creates a safety hazard in the respect that it creates ridges which are dangerous and slippery in bad weather and said type of construction tends to confuse motorists as to what lane or lanes they may or may not travel.

(5) In view of the problems created by a similar situation on Morton Avenue in Jacksonville, the Village believes that construction of four lanes of the same material, either blacktop or concrete, from Vandalia Road to the Central Illinois Expressway interchange would eliminate hazards and make traffic more freeflowing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Village is directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois with the request that said Department comment on the sentiments expressed herein.
