

ORDINANCE NO. 492

An Ordinance to Vacate an Alley Extending North from Greenwood Avenue to West Pennsylvania in the Village of South Jacksonville, County of Morgan and State of Illinois.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, County of Morgan, State of Illinois, have heretofore determined that the public interest will best be served by vacating a certain alley as hereinafter described, and;

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees have determined that there are no public service facilities lying within the said alley and that no property will be damaged by such vacation, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois:

Section 1. That a certain alley extending North from Greenwood Avenue to West Pennsylvania Avenue and bounded on the East by Lots 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25 in Gallaher's Addition to Jacksonville, now within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, and bounded on the West by Lots 36, 37, 38, 39, and 40 in the said Gallaher's Addition, be, and the same is, hereby vacated.

Section II. That the title to said street, described as aforesaid, upon the vacation thereof, shall vest in the owner or owners of land abutting thereon in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided.

Section III. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

PASSED at a regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, held in said Village on July 21, 1977, by the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of all Trustees authorized by law to be elected, the Trustees present voting "AYE" and "NAY" as follows:
