

ORDINANCE NO. 483

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF VILLAGE OFFICERS, HEREIN NAMED, TO BE HELD IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, ON THE 19th DAY OF APRIL, 1977.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That, as provided by law, a municipal election for the purpose of electing Village officers, shall be held in the Village of South Jacksonville, County of Morgan and State of Illinois, on the 19th day of April, 1977, said date being the third Tuesday in April and being the date prescribed by law for the holding of such municipal elections, for the election of Village officers, and at said Village municipal election the following Village officers shall be elected, to-wit:

Three Trustees for four (4) year terms.

Village Clerk for a four (4) year term

President of Board of Trustees for a four (4) year term.

Section 2. That for the purpose of said election the entire territory within the corporate limits of South Jacksonville, Illinois, be and it hereby is, designated as one polling precinct.

Section 3. That the polling place of said precinct shall be at the Village Hall, located on Dewey Drive in said Village.

Section 4. That the polls of such municipal election shall be opened on said date from the hours of six o'clock in the morning until six o'clock in the evening.

Section 5. That the following voters of the Village of South Jacksonville will be, and they are hereby appointed as Judges to hold said election:

Marjorie Prather

Rosemary Steelman

Barbara Madsen

Section 6. That after the close of the polls, the ballots shall be counted, the results declared and the returns made under seal to the Village Clerk, as provided by law.

Section 7. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to have ballots printed, to obtain the necessary supplies to conduct said election, to publish a sample ballot and to give notice of the election herein provided for, as provided by law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be and become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
