

ORDINANCE NUMBER 428


AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONNECTION OF SANITARY
OR INDUSTRIAL WASTE SEWERS TO STORM WATER DRAINAGE SYSTEMS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF _____
PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF _____

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to connect or cause to be connected, any drain carrying, or to carry, any toilet, sink, basement, septic tank, cesspool, industrial water, or any fixture or device discharging polluting substances, to any storm water drain

Section II. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than FIFTY dollars, nor more than One Hundred dollars for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each and every day during which a violation continues or exists.

EXHIBIT D

TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE PROVISIONS

The City shall:

1. Patrol the traffic control signal system a minimum of once every two (2) weeks and replace burned out lamps or damaged sockets as may be required. The reflector and lens should be cleaned each time a lamp is replaced.
2. Keep signal posts, controller pedestals, and foundations in alignment at all times.
3. Keep signal posts and controller pedestals tight on foundation.
4. Keep signal heads and controller cabinets tight on their pedestals and properly adjusted.
5. Keep detector equipment in proper working order at all times.
6. Check the controllers, relays, and detectors at least once every month to ascertain that they are functioning properly and make all necessary repairs and replacements.
7. Furnish and install temporary controller whenever necessary.
8. Keep interior of controller cabinets in a neat and workmanlike manner at all times.
9. Remove to clean and overhaul the controllers, relays, special auxiliary control equipment, and time clock once a year or oftener if necessary. A record tag shall be attached to each controller on which shall be indicated the date of overhaul or other service work.
10. Replace burned out fuses.
11. Clean reflectors, lenses, and lamps once every six (6) months.
12. Repaint all signal components exposed to weather at least once every two (2) years.
13. Group relamp traffic signal heads at the expiration of the average rated lamp life.
14. Repair or replace any and all equipment damaged by any cause whatsoever.
15. Be responsible to make recovery for damage to any part of the installation or systems from the party causing the damage.
16. Place a stop sign on each approach to the intersection as a temporary means of regulating traffic whenever repairs at a signalized intersection require that the controller be disconnected.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this ____ day of May, 1973, by and between the VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, A Municipal Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Village", and ABRAHAM RAINVILLE, hereinafter referred to as "Builder".

WHEREAS, Builder desires to construct an eight-inch cast iron water main commencing at a point in Vandalia Road approximately one hundred (100) feet west of the elevated water tank owned by Village and extending in a westerly direction in the right of way of said Vandalia Road for a distance of three hundred (300) feet and further desires that the Village accept said water main as a part of the Village water system and be responsible for the maintenance of the same and further desires that an agreement be made between Village and Builder whereby Builder may be reimbursed for the cost of constructing said water main.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED as follows:

(1) The Village hereby grants permission to Builder to construct at his own expense the water main hereinabove described and further grants to him the right to connect said water main with the existing water main owned by the Village. The construction of said water main shall conform strictly to the plans and specifications therefor prepared by Devore-Bobb & Associates, Consulting Engineers.

(2) The plans and specifications for said water main shall be approved by all state regulatory agencies and all permits required for the construction of the same shall be secured prior to commencement of construction.

(3) Builder shall give the Village reasonable advance notice of the date of commencement of construction so that said Village may make such inspections as it may deem appropriate during the course of the construction work and said water main shall not be covered by back-fill or other material until such time as the Village advises Builder that it has inspected the water main in place and is satisfied with its installation. In the event Builder fails to comply with any of the foregoing or any of the other provisions herein required of him, the Village will not accept said water main and will not permit it to be attached to the Village water system.

(4) Construction of said water main shall not give the Builder or those persons connecting to said water main any greater right or privilege in relation to the use of water from the Village of South Jacksonville than is now presently vested in all other residents of said Village and Builder and all persons connecting to said water main shall pay the Village for all water used at the regularly established rates applicable to water users residing in said Village.

(5) Upon satisfactory completion of said water main Builder shall execute a proper dedication of the same to the Village of South Jacksonville releasing all right, title and interest therein to said Village and thereupon, said Village:

A. Will maintain said water main pursuant to the standards of maintenance and care applied by said Village to all its water mains.

B. Will not permit any abutting property owners on either the North or the South sides of Vandalia Road within the area of said water main extension to connect to said water main without requiring the payment of a reasonable connection fee which shall fairly represent a pro-rata share of the cost of said water main. It being the intention of the parties hereto that Builder shall be fully reimbursed for the costs of installing said water main in the event all abutting properties are connected to said water main.

C. The Village will deliver to Builder all connecting fees collected by it pursuant to the provisions hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, A Municipal Corporation, has caused this instrument to be executed in its name by its President and attested by its Clerk and its Corporate Seal to be hereto affixed and Abraham Rainville has hereunto affixed his signature this ____ day of May, 1973.

RESOLUTION APPROVING PLAT
