

ORDINANCE NO. 413

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR
 THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH
 THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1972
 AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING
 THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1973

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, that a tax for the following sums of money or as much thereof as may be authorized by law to defray all expenses and liabilities of the Village, be and the same is hereby levied for the purpose specified against all taxable property in the Village for the fiscal year commencing with the Third Tuesday in April, 1972, and ending with the Monday preceding the Third Tuesday in April, 1973.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, exercising the powers and performing the duties of a Highway Commissioner of Road District No. 15, Morgan County, Illinois,

That it is hereby determined that the amounts necessary to be raised by taxation for the purpose of construction of roads, the maintenance of roads, the maintenance of bridges, the purchase of machinery, the repairs to machinery, respectively, in said Road District No. 15 for the year, A. D. 1972, are as follows:

For the construction of roads	\$ 4,000.00
For the maintenance of roads	5,000.00
For the maintenance of bridges	500.00
For the oiling of roads	6,000.00
For the purchase of machinery	4,000.00
For repairs to machinery	<u>1,500.00</u>
TOTAL	\$21,000.00

to be levied against all of said Road District No. 15, as assessed for the year A. D. 1972, and that said amount of money, or so much thereof as may be approved by the County Board of said Morgan County be and the same is hereby levied for road and bridge taxes against all the taxable property of said Road District No. 15 for the year A. D. 1972.

We, the undersigned, members of the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, acting as and exercising the powers vested by law in a Highway Commissioner of Road District No. 15 of Morgan County, Illinois, do hereby certify that a meeting was held in the Village Hall of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, in said Road District No. 15, on the first Tuesday in September, in the year A. D. 1972, being the 5th day of September, A. D. 1972, for the purpose of determining the amounts of money necessary for roads, bridges, machinery and repairs and to be certified to the County Board.


We do further certify that at said annual meeting held in the Village Hall of said Village of South Jacksonville, in said Road District No. 15, on the first Tuesday in September in the year A. D. 1972, being the 5th day of September, A. D. 1972, we determined that the several amounts of money necessary to be levied and raised by taxation for the construction of roads, the maintenance of roads, the maintenance of bridges, the purchase of machinery, the repairs of machinery, respectively, in said Road District No. 15 for the year A. D. 1972, are as follows:


For the construction of roads	\$ 4,000.00
For the maintenance of roads	5,000.00
For the maintenance of bridges	500.00
For the oiling of roads	6,000.00
For the purchase of machinery	4,000.00
For repairs to machinery	<u>1,500.00</u>


TOTAL \$21,000.00

Thus making the total amount necessary to be raised by taxation for the proper construction, maintenance and repair of roads, and for the proper maintenance and repairs of bridges, the purchase and repair of machinery in said Road District No. 15 for said year, Twenty-one Thousand Dollars (\$21,000.00) and it is hereby directed that the said amount of money, or so much thereof as may be approved by the County Board of said County, be and the same is hereby levied as road and bridge taxes against all the taxable property of said Road District No. 15, for the year A. D. 1972.

RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE UNDER THE ILLINOIS POLICE TRAINING ACT

WHEREAS, The Village of South Jacksonville is desirous of electing to participate in the program under the ILLINOIS POLICE TRAINING ACT, as enacted by the 74th General Assembly of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, in order that The Village of South Jacksonville be eligible for initial or continued participation in the program, the law requires that before an individual may commence regular employment as a policeman, he must have been certified by the ILLINOIS LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TRAINING BOARD as having successfully completed an approved training course; and

WHEREAS, the Village of South Jacksonville intends to establish its own school or to utilize some other school certified by said Board for the purpose of providing the basic training required under said Act;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of South Jacksonville hereby elects to participate in the program provided for in the ILLINOIS POLICE TRAINING ACT.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that before an individual may commence regular employment as a policeman, he must have been certified by the ILLINOIS LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TRAINING BOARD as having successfully completed an approved training course as provided in said Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such basic training must be completed by the trainee within his probationary period of six months.
