

ORDINANCE NO. 405

ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL USE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That Gratia Hall Coultas and Illinois Power Company, their Successors and Assigns, are hereby authorized to use the following described premises for an electrical substation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7.2 - 17 of the South Jacksonville Zoning Ordinance. Said property herein concerned is described as follows:

Part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirty-Two (32), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Ten (10) West of the Third Principal Meridian, Morgan County, Illinois, described as follows:


Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section Thirty-Two (32), thence running West 264 feet, thence South 330 feet, thence East 264 feet, and thence North 330 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That said authorization is conditioned upon and subject to compliance by said Gratia Hall Coultas and Illinois Power Company, their Successors and Assigns, with all other applicable provisions of the South Jacksonville Zoning Ordinance and rules, regulations, ordinances, laws and statutes of the Village of South Jacksonville and State of Illinois and is further conditioned upon the provision that construction of the electrical substation on the above described premises shall be completed in accordance with plans previously submitted and on file with the South Jacksonville Village Board.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and recording as provided by ordinance and law. PASSED at a regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, this 18th day of November, 1971.
