

Ordinance No. 298

An Ordinance To Amend An Ordinance  
Entitled: "Ordinance No. 8, Relating  
To Licenses" Approved And Adopted  
January 10, 1912.

Whereas, it is deemed necessary to amend an ordinance  
entitled "Ordinance No. 8, Relating To Licenses" approved and  
adopted January 10, 1912.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the President and Board  
of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County,  
Illinois that an ordinance entitled: "Ordinance No. 8 Relating to  
licenses approved and adopted January 10, 1912 be amended by  
adding the following paragraph thereto.

Division Seven.  
Amusement Rides

Section One. That no person shall own, keep or operate a  
kiddie-ride or any ride of similar nature for use of the  
general public without first obtaining a license therefore.  
The rate of license for such amusement equipment shall be  
\$1.00 a day, ~~75¢~~ for three months or ~~20¢~~ <sup>per week</sup> per year. No  
license shall authorize the operation of any kiddie-ride  
or similar equipment in contravention of any other ordinance  
of the Village. <sup>Any person violating any provision of this</sup> ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$1.00  
nor more than \$50.00.
