

ORDINANCE NO. 288

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION
FOR THE OFFICE OF VILLAGE ATTORNEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1.

That the Village attorney shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$50.00) per month and in addition thereto the Village attorney shall be paid the sum of Twenty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$25.00) for attendance at any additional meeting of the President and Board of Trustees in excess of the two regular monthly meetings and also the same sum for attendance at any board, agency or function of said Village where his attendance is requested by the President or Board of Trustees; in addition thereto the Village attorney shall be compensated for all out-of-pocket expenses and further the Village attorney shall receive such compensation as the President and Board of Trustees may determine to be reasonable for services rendered in connection with bond issues, special assessment proceedings and the preparation and trial of cases in court. It being the determination of the President and Board of Trustees that the minimum schedule of bar fees adopted by the Morgan County Bar Association shall be used.

Section 2.

All ordinances in conflict hereof are to be and the same

are hereby repealed.
