

ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
PROHIBITING OF PARKING IN CERTAIN
AREAS ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS IN
THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE,
ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, it is for the best welfare of the VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE and its inhabitants and for the safety and protection of the fire fighting equipment of said Village that parking upon the streets and alleys of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, be controlled, regulated and prohibited at certain places.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, Morgan County, Illinois:

SECTION 1:

That all parking of vehicles be and the same are hereby prohibited within a distance of fifteen (15) feet from all fire hydrants located within the corporate limits of the VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS and that the street and alley department be and they hereby are authorized and directed to post appropriate "No Parking" signs upon the streets and alleys within said Village prohibiting parking within the distance of fifteen (15) feet from each side of all fire hydrants located in the Village.

SECTION 2:

That the parking or stopping of vehicles upon the streets and alleys of said Village where the same blocks an entrance to another street, private drive or alleyway, be and the same is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2a:

That the parking or stopping of vehicles upon the streets and alleys of said Village within fifty (50) feet of a rail or railroad grade crossing be and the same is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 3:

That the parking of any vehicle upon the streets or alleys of the VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE within fifteen (15) feet of any intersection of the street on which the said vehicle is parked with another street or alley be and the same is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 4:

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance is subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation of this Ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
