

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE
No. 128 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHARGES OR RATES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS"
PASSED AND APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 20, 1939

WHEREAS there is now in full force and effect Ordinance No. 128 entitled "An Ordinance establishing charges or rates for the use and service of the sewerage system of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois," passed and approved on the 20th day of September, 1939, and;

WHEREAS it is necessary that Section 1 of said Ordinance be amended to provide for charges to the public schools and public buildings within the corporate limits of said Village for the reason that the City of Jacksonville, who provides the sewerage service in said Village has by contract placed charges upon the Village ^{for such} services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows: That Section 1 of an Ordinance #128, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing charges or rates for the use and service of the sewerage system of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois" passed and approved on September 20, 1939, be and is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1

That there shall be and there are hereby established rates or charges for the use and service supplied by the sewerage system of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, based upon the connections with said system, and the number of users as determined by the Board of Trustees, or its duly appointed representatives as follows:

A. Residential use - For every house connected with the sewerage system there shall be a minimum charge

annually of nine dollars (\$9.00) and there shall be an additional charge of two dollars twenty-five cents (\$2.25) for each person over four (4) in number residing in such dwelling house.

B. For Commercial and Industrial Use - For every business connected with the sewerage system of said Village, there shall be a minimum charge of twelve dollars (\$12.00) annually, and there shall be an additional charge of three dollars (\$3.00) for each employee over four (4) in number employed at each place of business.

C. For Public Schools - For each public school building there shall be a charge of two dollars twenty-five cents (\$2.25) annually for each child of a non-resident of the Village or City attending said school.

D. For Public Buildings - For all other public buildings, excepting public school buildings, connected to the Village sewer, there shall be a charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) annually.

E. For Sewerage Connections with residences other than those within the Village limits - There shall be a minimum fee of twelve dollars (\$12.00) annually for each sewerage connection with residents other than those within the Village limits, and there shall be an additional charge of three dollars (\$3.00) for each person over four (4) in number residing in any such dwelling house connected with the sewerage system of the Village. Except however ~~some~~ charges shall not apply to those residents of the City of Jacksonville residing on the North side of East Michigan Avenue as covered by Contract dated November 18, 1946, between the City and Village as the same has been duly and regularly extended.

Said charges are to be annual charges for use of the sewerage system commencing on July 1, 1959 and each July 1st in the years thereafter.

PASSED at a regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville on this 2 day of July, A. D., 1959.
