

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 198 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A WHEEL TAX IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, AND FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF", PASSED AND APPROVED JUNE 26, 1951.

WHEREAS, there is now in full force and effect Ordinance No. 198 entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A WHEEL TAX IN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS, AND FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF,"

which ordinance was passed and approved on the 26th day of June, 1951; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville did represent to the citizens and voters of said Village that said tax would be repealed at such time as receipt of said tax was not necessary for the repair and maintenance of Village streets; and

WHEREAS, due to increases in certain other taxes and charges it is necessary for the best interests of the Village and its inhabitants that strict economy be practiced by the Village of South Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, said wheel tax ordinance may be repealed and the tax no longer collected for a period of time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, ~~Section~~ that Ordinance No. 198 entitled:
