

ORDINANCE No. 270

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 177 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF TRAILERS FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORGAN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS" PASSED AND ADOPTED ON THE 4th DAY OF MAY, 1949.

WHEREAS, it is deemed best for the public interests of the Village of South Jacksonville and its inhabitants that Ordinance No. 177 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF TRAILERS FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORGAN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS" passed and adopted on the 4th day of May, 1949, be amended to allow the use of trailers for residential purposes to be used in certain restricted areas; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend said ordinance to provide for the use of trailers for residential purposes in certain restricted areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1: That Section 2 of an ordinance entitled, "ORDINANCE NO. 177, AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF TRAILERS FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORGAN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS" passed and adopted on May 4, 1949, be amended as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 2: This ordinance, and the prohibition herein contained, shall not apply to the use or occupancy of such a trailer by an itinerant person or persons, nor shall this ordinance, and the prohibition herein contained apply to the use or occupancy of such a trailer by one or more persons who,

during the occupancy thereof, are engaged in the construction of a residential unit for their own use or occupancy after the completion thereof; and further this ordinance and the prohibition herein contained shall not apply to the use or occupancy of such a trailer by one or more persons who reside in the same on a commercial trailer court, which said trailer courts upon complying with all the laws and statutes of the State of Illinois and the Village of South Jacksonville may be established in any area commercially zoned under the zoning ordinance of said Village of South Jacksonville. The establishment of such trailer courts are to be allowed only in commercially zoned areas and are specifically excluded from all residentially zoned areas or areas zoned for industrial purposes.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

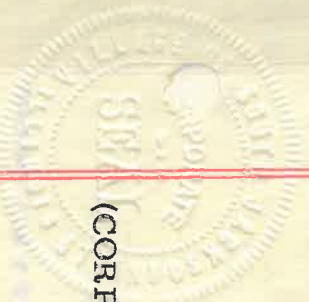
