

ORDINANCE NO. 269

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1958, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY LAST PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1959.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, in the County of Morgan, State of Illinois, did on the 1st day of May, A. D., 1958, pass the Annual Appropriation Bill for said Village of South Jacksonville for the fiscal year beginning on the third Tuesday in April, 1958, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April, 1959; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, in the County of Morgan, State of Illinois, did on the 19th day of June, A. D., 1958, pass Ordinance No. 268, an Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 263, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN AMOUNTS FOR CERTAIN CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1958, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY LAST PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1959;" and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance and the amendment thereto, both were duly passed and adopted during the first quarter of the fiscal year of said Village; and

WHEREAS, publication of the Ordinance and the Ordinance amending said Appropriation Bill were both duly published in the first quarter of the fiscal year of said Village; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance and the Ordinance amending the same provide for a total appropriation in the amount of \$104,950.00 for the fiscal year beginning on the third Tuesday in April, 1958, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April, 1959;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SECTION 1: That there be and hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said Village for the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April, 1958, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April, 1959, the total sum of Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00), for the following specific purposes mentioned in said Appropriation Bill and amendment thereto, and respective sums as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 2: That there be, and there hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1958, pursuant to the authorization of Article 39, Chapter 24, of the Revised Statutes of Illinois, heretofore adopted at a special election duly and regularly held on November 7, 1950, the total sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and amendment thereto and in the sum as follows:

SECTION 3: That there be, and there hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1958, pursuant to the authorization of Article 40, Chapter 24, Revised Statutes of Illinois, the total sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1, 800. 00) for the following specific purpose mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the sum as follows:

For garbage disposal	\$3, 000. 00	\$1, 800. 00

SECTION 4: That there be, and there hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1958, pursuant to the authorization of Article 84, Paragraph 33-b, Chapter 24, Revised Statutes of Illinois, the total sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500. 00) for the following specific purpose mentioned in the appropriation bill and in the sum as follows:

SECTION 5: That there be, and there hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1958, pursuant to the authorization of Section 281 of Chapter 127, Revised Statutes of State of Illinois, the total sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500. 00) for the following specific purposes mentioned in the appropriation bill as amended in the sum as follows:

For civil defense equipment	\$1, 000. 00	\$ 500. 00

SECTION 6: The Village Clerk of said Village of South Jacksonville is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Morgan County, a duly certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance to take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville at their regular meeting held on the 21 day of August, 1958, in the Village Hall in said Village.
