

ORDINANCE NO. 256.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE GROWING OF CORN AND OTHER CULTIVATED CROPS ON CORNER LOTS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the growing of corn and other cultivated crops upon lots and parcels of real estate adjacent to street intersections within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville creates hazards as to the movement of traffic in and out of said intersections; and

WHEREAS, it is for the best interests of the Village and its inhabitants that the growing of such crops be controlled and regulated to insure that the same will not obstruct the vision of drivers of automobiles and other vehicles entering or leaving said intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of this ordinance a corner lot is defined as any tract, lot or parcel of property which is adjacent to the intersection of two streets within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any owner or person in possession of a corner lot to plant and allow to grow in excess of three (3) feet in height any cultivated crop such as corn, sun flowers or similar vegetation, within one hundred (100) feet of any street intersection within the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation who violates this ordinance shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00), nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense. Each day such violation continues shall be considered as a separate offense.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
