

ORDINANCE NO. 246.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF
VEHICLES ON EAST MICHIGAN AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles on East Michigan Avenue near the intersection of South Main Street in said Village, is creating a hazardous and dangerous condition to the use of the streets and safety of persons and inhabitants of said Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: The following words whenever they are used in this ordinance shall have the meaning respectively, to-wit:

- (a) Park - standing vehicles, whether occupied or not, for a period of time greater than is reasonably necessary for the actual loading or unloading of persons or cargo.
- (b) Vehicle - every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a street or highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

SECTION TWO: It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on the south side of East Michigan Avenue from a point commencing at the east sidewalk line on South Main Street to a point 120 feet east thereof.

SECTION THREE: That signs reading "No Parking" shall be erected in said area.

SECTION FOUR: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each violation of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
