

ORDINANCE NO. 235

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING AND REGULATING
THE NUMBERING OF PROPERTY FRONTING ON
THE STREETS OF SAID VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, it is advisable and necessary to insure proper fire and police protection for the inhabitants of said Village, and their property, that all of the property in said Village fronting upon the streets in said Village be numbered in an orderly sequence according to their location in said Village, and:

WHEREAS, upon certain streets of said Village, properties are not now consecutively numbered in an orderly sequence which thereby creates confusion and delays the fire and police department in the fulfillment of their duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: For the purpose of this Ordinance only, whenever the word "lot" is used it shall mean a tract of land having fifty front feet upon a street within said Village.

SECTION 2: Each lot shall have a separate number.

SECTION 3: All lots fronting on streets running north and south shall be numbered consecutively commencing with the lot at the north end of the street. All even numbers to be on the east side of the street and all odd numbers to be on the west side of the street.

SECTION 4: All lots on streets ^{fronting} running east and west in said Village shall be numbered consecutively commencing with the lot nearest to South Main Street in said Village. All even numbers to be on the north side of the street and all odd numbers to be on the south side of the street.

SECTION 5: All lots on streets not included in paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Ordinance to be numbered consecutively
