

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC
TO PROTECT VOLUNTEER FIRE
DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS it is necessary for the protection of the South Jacksonville Volunteer Fire Department and its inhabitants that suitable protection and ordinances be enacted to assure the prompt arrival by the fire department to fires occurring in the Village and for Ordinances to protect the equipment and personnel of said fire department when going to and combating fires, that suitable traffic regulations be enacted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois.

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to run over or across any fire hose laid by the fire department of said Village to combat a fire.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct or delay or hinder the fire department in its progress from the fire station in said Village to the scene of a fire. Drivers of all vehicles upon hearing the siren affixed to the fire truck shall immediately drive their vehicles to the curb of the street upon which they are traveling, and remain there until the fire truck has passed.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person not a member of the Village Fire Department to follow the fire equipment of said Village to the scene of a fire.

SECTION 4. Any person, Firm or Corporation, violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

Passed at a regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, this 18th day of March, A.D., 1954.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 224
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TRAFFIC SIGNS AND THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF," APPROVED APRIL 2, 1952, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to amend an Ordinance entitled: "An Ordinance Providing For Traffic Signs and The Enforcement Thereof," approved April 2, 1952;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, that an Ordinance entitled: "An Ordinance Providing For Traffic Signs and The Enforcement Thereof," approved April 2, 1952, be amended by adding the following paragraph thereto.

SECTION 3-b. That Dewey Drive at the intersection of Sandy Street and it hereby is directed to be a through street at the intersection named, and the traffic entering at said intersection onto said through street shall come to a full and complete stop before entering said intersection; and further, there shall be erected and maintained a suitable stop sign requiring all traffic to stop as aforesaid.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 228
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AT FIRES AND THE PROTECTION OF FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the protection of the Village and the property of its inhabitants that suitable Ordinances be passed to assure the prompt arrival by the fire department at fires in the Village and for Ordinances to protect the equipment and personnel of said fire department when fighting said fires.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois.

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to run over or across any fire hose laid by the fire department of said Village to combat a fire.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct or delay or hinder the fire department in its progress from the fire station in said Village to the scene of a fire. Drivers of all vehicles upon hearing the siren affixed to the fire truck shall immediately drive their vehicles to the curb of the street upon which they are traveling, and remain there until the fire truck has passed.
