

AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE NO. 105⁶
RELATING TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS,
OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS,
AND ALL AMENDMENTS THEREFO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, ILLINOIS: That an Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Relating to the Sale of Alcoholic Liquors", passed by the Village Board of South Jacksonville, Illinois, on April 4th, A. D. 1934, and the Amendment to an Ordinance No. 105 Relating to the Sale of Alcoholic Liquors, of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, passed by the Village Board of South Jacksonville, Illinois, on the 25th day of April, A. D. 1934, be and the same are hereby amended as follows:

I. The following paragraph of an Amendment to an Ordinance No. 105 Relating to the Sale of Alcoholic Liquors, of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, is hereby repealed:

"Section 10-A. Licensees under this ordinance are given and granted permission and approval of the said Village Board of South Jacksonville, Illinois, to sell said alcoholic liquors and other beverages mentioned in Section 2, paragraph 5 on Sunday as well as on week days."

II. To Section 10 of said Ordinance, after Paragraph 3 thereof, shall be added:

"4. The sale of any alcoholic liquors on the day of any national, state, county, municipal or village election, including primary elections, during the hours the polls are open within the political area within which such election is being held.

"5. Sales of alcoholic liquor at retail on Sunday.

"6. Dancing on licensed premises, or in any room or rooms adjacent thereto, or on the upper floor or floors of such licensed premises where such room or rooms are under the control of such licensee."

III. There shall be added to said Ordinance a new Section, as follows:

"Section 4. A. BOND. Except where otherwise provided herein, each person desiring a license shall execute a penal bond in form and with security satisfactory to the Village Board and the President, conditioned upon the faithful observance of the provisions of the laws of the Village of South Jacksonville, of the State of Illinois, and of this Ordinance. Such bond shall be in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) in the case of a 'Night Club License'."

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. Whereas this Ordinance amending an Ordinance No. 105 Relating to the Sale of Alcoholic Liquors, of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, and all amendments thereto, is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health and safety, an emergency for its immediate passage and taking effect is hereby declared to exist, and it shall, therefore, take effect from and after its passage, signing, recording and posting.

Passed by the Village Board of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, at an adjourned meeting held on the Fifth day of July, A. D. 1934.
