

Tax Levy Ordinance .
Ordinance No. 116

Tax Levy Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April 1936 and ending with the Monday last preceding the third Tuesday in April 1937.

Be it ordained by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois .

Section 1 . That there be and hereby is, levied upon all property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of the village of South Jacksonville, Illinois as the same is assessed and equalized for the state and county purposes, for the current year, the sum of fifty-five hundred dollars (\$5500) for general purposes and in the amounts herein after set forth, said amount having been here to fore appropriated in the annual appropriation ordinance of the said Village .

For opening, improving, cleaning and repairing the streets and alleys	\$ 2100.
For street lighting	600.
For salaries	500.
For fire department	600.
For water mains	800.
For public building fund	500.
For public benefit fund	300.
For sundry expenses	100.
<hr/>	
Total	\$ 5500.

Section 2 . That all unexpended balances of any item or items for the general purposes may be used or expended to make up deficits in any item or items herein specified .

The above tax levy ordinance was approved and passed at the regular meeting of the Village Board on August 5th 1936 , by a unanimous vote of the trustees .
