

Annual Appropriation Ordinance

For the fiscal year beginning with the third Tuesday in April 1938 and ending with the Monday last preceeding the third Tuesday in April 1939 .

Ordinance # 119 .

Be it ordained by the President and the board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois :

That there be and be hereby appropriated for the above said fiscal year . for the use of the said Village of South Jacksonville, the sum of One hundred Thousand Dollars, for the purposes and in the amounts here in after set forth.
