AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, OF AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A SEWERAGE SYSTEM, OF AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$17,000 SEWERAGE BONDS, AND THE PROPOSITION OF OPERATING A SEWERAGE SYSTEM, AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN AND FOR SAID VILLAGE ON February 21, 1939.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, did on the 4th day of January, 1939, adopt an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance providing for the construction, maintenance and operation of a sewerage system in and for the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois," and an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance providing for borrowing money and issuing bonds of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, to the amount of \$17,000 for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing a sewerage system in and for said Village and providing for the collection of a direct annual tax for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds;" and

WHEREAS, before said Village is authorized to construct a sewerage system and operate the same, it is necessary that the proposition of operating such a system be submitted to the legal voters and approved by a majority of the voters voting on the question at an election duly called and held for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, before said ordinances, hereinabove referred to, become effective they must be submitted to the legal voters of said Village and be approved by a majority of the legal voters voting upon the propositions at an election duly called and held for that purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance providing for the construction, maintenance and operation of a sewerage system in and for the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois," and an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance providing for borrowing money and issuing bonds of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, to the amount of \$17,000, for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing a sewerage system in and for said Village, and providing for the collection of a direct annual tax for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds," adopted by the President and Board of Trustees of said Village, on January 4, 1939, and the proposition of authorizing the Village of South Jacksonville to operate a sewerage system and charge rates for the service to be performed thereby, be submitted to the voters of said Village at a special election which is hereby called to be held in said Village on February 21, 1939, between the hours of six o'clock in the morning and five o'clock in the afternoon of said day.

Section 2. That for the purpose of said election the corporate limits of the Village of South Jacksonville shall constitute one election precinct, and the polling place for said election is hereby established as follows: The Village Hall in Dewey Park in the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois.

Section 3. That for said election the following named persons be and they are hereby designated judges and clerks of said election, to-wit:

Section 4. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to cause at least forty (40) days' notice of said election to be given by posting notice thereof in at least ten (10) of the most public places within said Village and at the polling place herein designated, there being no newspaper published in and of general circulation within said Village, and that said posted notices be in substantially the following form:

To the Voters of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois:

NOTICE is hereby given that a special election will be held in and for said Village on February 21, 1939, at the Village Hall in Dewey Park in the Village of South Jacksonville, Illinois, polling place, at which time there will be submitted to the voters of said Village the following ordinances:

There will also be submitted at said election the following proposition:

Shall the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, be authorized to operate a sewerage system and charge rates for the service to be performed thereby?

Polls of said election will be opened at six o'clock in the morning and will be closed at five o'clock in the evening. All persons qualified to vote at regular Village elections are qualified to vote at said special election.

2. AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF \$17,000 SEWERAGE BONDS

Shall bonds of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, in the sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000) be issued by the President and Board of Trustees of said Village of South Jacksonville for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing a sewerage system in and for said Village, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent (4½%) per

annum end to mature \$1,000 on December 1 in each of the years 1941 to 1957, inclusive, and a tax be levied to pay principal of and interest on said bonds, all as provided by an ordinance adopted by the President and Board of Trustees of said Village on January 4, 1939, entitled "An Ordinance providing for borrowing money and issuing bonds of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, to the amount of Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000) for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing a sewerage system in and for said Village and providing for the collection of a direct annual tax for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds."?

On the back of said ballot shall appear the following:
