

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE DISTANCE  
FROM STREET LINES AT WHICH BUILDINGS  
MAY BE ERECTED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees  
of the Village of South Jacksonville:

SEC. 1. No building shall hereafter be erected, constructed  
or built for any purpose, closer than forty (40) feet from the west  
boundary line of South Main Street, nor closer than Forty (40) feet  
from the East Boundary line of South Main Street, in the Village of  
South Jacksonville;

SEC. 2. No building shall hereafter be erected, constructed,  
or built, for any purpose, closer to the boundary line of any Street  
in the Village of South Jacksonville, except South Main Street, than  
the nearest residence building on either side of the street thereof;

SEC. 3. Any person, persons or corporations violating  
either Section 1 or Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be fined the  
sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and an additional sum of Five (\$5.00)  
Dollars per day for each day any building erected, constructed or  
built in violation of either Section 1 or 2 of this Ordinance shall  
be allowed to stand after the same is erected.

SEC. 4. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance  
are hereby repealed.
