

ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE
OF SOUTH JACKSONVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY,
STATE OF ILLINOIS

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL,
1939, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY LAST
PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1940.

ORDINANCE #127

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the
Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois:

That there be, and there is hereby levied upon all property sub-
ject to taxation within the corporate limits of the Village of South
Jacksonville, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for the
State and County purposes, for the year beginning with the third Tuesday
in April, 1939, and ending with the Monday last preceding the third
Tuesday in April, 1940, the sum of Sixty-six hundred and thirty-nine
Dollars for general purposes and for the payment of interest on general
obligation bonds and in the amounts hereinafter set forth, said amounts
having been heretofore appropriated in the annual appropriation
ordinance of the said Village.

For opening, widening, improving, oiling and repairing streets and alleys of the Village	\$2,000.00
For street lighting fund	600.00
For Salaries	400.00
For Fire Department	400.00
For Water mains	1,000.00
For Sundry and incidental expenses	300.00
For Public Building fund	100.00
For Court Costs	500.00
For Interest on General Obligation Sewer Bonds	1,239.00
