

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1943, AND ENDING WITH THE MONDAY PRECEDING THE THIRD TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1944.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of South Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois, that there be and there is hereby levied upon all taxable property within said Village for the fiscal year beginning with the Third Tuesday in April, 1943, and ending with the Monday last preceding the Third Tuesday in April, 1944, the sum of Four Thousand Six Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$4630.00) for the purposes and in the amounts hereinafter set forth:

For opening, widening, improving, oiling, graveling, and repairing streets and alleys	\$ 900.00
For street lighting	550.00
For salaries	450.00
For rental of fire equipment	200.00
For sewage disposal and treatment	900.00
For payment of principal and interest on general obligation bonds	1630.00
